

**FULTON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING  
FOR JULY 11, 2016**

The Fulton County Drainage Board met on Monday, July 11, 2016 in the Conference Room of the Fulton County Office Building at 9:00 A.M. The following people were in attendance: Chairman Roger Rose, Vice-Chairman Bryan Lewis, Commissioner Sherry Fulton, Surveyor Don Towne, Secretary Kasey Hensley, and Attorney Greg Heller.

**RE: SET PUBLIC HEARING- #823 THOMAS MOGEL OPEN/CAUSE #4-2016**

Surveyor Don Towne requested the Board set a public hearing to establish Maintenance on the #823 Thomas Mogel Open, Cause #4-2016. The proposed Maintenance rate is \$8.00/benefitted acre with a \$10.00 minimum.

Chairman Roger Rose entertained a motion to set a public hearing for Monday, September 12, 2016 at 9:30 A.M. to establish Maintenance at a proposed rate of \$8.00/benefitted acre with a \$10.00 minimum. The motion was made, seconded and passed 3-0.

**RE: BOB PETERSON- FUTURE PRIVATE TILE PROJECT**

Bob Peterson addressed the Board concerning a future private tile project on parcel #009-119190-00, containing 31.722 acres. The property is located on the north side of the Fulton County Highway facility. Bob gave a verbal overview of the project to the Board offering the option to allow the County to place a positive outlet into his system. Chairman Roger Rose inquired if County Highway Superintendant Rick Ranstead was aware of the option. Bob stated he has not spoken to Rick but will inform Rick and see if there is any validity to access a potential outlet.

**RE: #821 GEORGE WILSON OPEN-DELINEATION**

Surveyor Don Towne informed the Board he contacted three companies regarding delineation. At this time only one has responded.

**RE: INDIANA FARM BUREAU FARM SCHOOL**

A citizen submitted a newspaper clipping for the Indiana Farm Bureau's Drainage School. He wrote a note with the submission strongly suggesting the Board attend and learn something.

**RE: MAINTENANCE CERTIFICATION- #628 & #813**

The Board signed the Certification of Maintenance for:

#628 Edmon Tippy Tile, Cause #43-1967, increase from \$0.99/benefitted acre with a \$5.00 minimum to \$3.00/benefitted acre with a \$10.00 minimum.

#813 WF Wilson Tile, Cause #1-2012, decrease from \$7.00/benefitted acre with a \$10.00 minimum to \$5.00/benefitted acre with a \$10.00 minimum.

**RE: INDIAN CREEK #779 MEETING**

Vice-Chairman Roger Rose informed the Board Indian Creek will meet again in September 2016. There has not been a hearing date set yet, but the Board is looking to mail public hearing notices before the end of the year.

**RE: PUBLIC HEARING- #822 SMITH HEIGHWAY TILE, CAUSE #3-2016**

Chairman Roger Rose called to order the Public Hearing of the Smith Heighway Tile #822, Cause #3-2016. The tile contains 289.19 benefitted acres containing 11 properties. The purpose of this hearing is to establish Maintenance at a proposed rate of \$6.00/benefitted acre with a \$10.00 minimum. At this time there are three written objections: Michael Boldry- cost is excessive; Larry & Mary Arven-no benefit & no taxation; and Brent Arven- no benefit and no taxation. Landowner Dale Smith was present at the meeting.

The tile is a ditch of county record. Surveyor Don Towne informed the Board of the condition of the system. Presently one of the landowners planted two trees on the tile, which consequently has broken the tile causing water to bubble out. This is causing drainage issues for the neighbors. The upper end of the tile is wetland with a control system.

There was a brief discussion about the system and options for the repair. Chairman Roger Rose entertained a motion to precede with the proposal to establish Maintenance on the #822 Smith Heighway Tile, Cause #2-2016 with a rate of \$6.00/benefitted acre with a \$10.00 minimum. The motion was made, seconded and passed 3-0.

**RE: OFFICE KEYS**

Surveyor Don Towne stated he has yet to receive his office key after three months. Vice-Chairman Bryan Lewis stated he spoke to I.T. Director Josh Shriver and was unaware as to why he hasn't received a key.
