ORDINANCE NO. 040317 AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OPEN BURNING IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF FULTON COUNTY

WHEREAS, open burning in certain areas of Fulton County, Indiana, causes potential health and safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fulton County, Indiana, is authorized by the laws of Indiana to govern the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Fulton County, Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fulton County Board of Commissioners and Fulton County Council as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the open burning of any matter or material, except as specified in paragraph 2 below, within the following described areas of Fulton County, Indiana, and as illustrated on Exhibit A, attached an incorporated:

Beginning at the intersection of 13th St and HW US 31, the north boundary being properties directly North of 13th Street, East to the western city boundary line, South along the West city boundary line to the east right of way of HW US 31, North along the East right of way back to the intersection of 13th Street.

- 2. Residents of Fulton County, Indiana, within the designated areas in Section 1 above, may burn charcoal and/or wood in outdoor fireplaces and grills provided that the fireplaces or grills shall be placed in such a location as to be reasonably removed from any neighboring residence so as to avoid any smoke or fumes therefrom becoming a nuisance for any adjacent neighbor.
- 3. In the event that there are such unusual circumstances as to make the burning of a substantial amount of combustible matter desirable, any person wishing to burn any such material shall make a request to the Commissioners of Fulton County, Indiana, for permission to burn such combustible material. Any requests shall be considered by the Commissioners of Fulton County, Indiana, and, if authorized by the Commissioners, any such burning will be done under the supervision of the appropriate fire department.

- 4. Any violation of this Ordinance may be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,500.
- 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after publication required by law.
