Failure to file in the proper office may affect the perfection of the lien. **Amendments** on **financing statements** should be transferred to the State. Beginning 7/01/02 County Recorder's Office will accept **fixture filings**, **searches**, **amendments and terminations**. Upon accepting a **fixture filing** either box 6 or 13 must be checked upon the UCC Form.

Any cross outs or white outs must be initialed and an additional \$1.00 conforming fee will be charged.

All documents must meet recording form and legibility statutes.
