

# Fulton County COVID-19 Vaccination Distribution

Starting January 11<sup>th</sup> individuals 80 years of age and older are eligible to receive the COVID vaccine.

## Current Eligibility Requirements:

- Health Care Personnel – including all healthcare facility staff who have direct contact with patients, other facilities, and providers such as in-home providers
- Long Term Care Facility Residents
- Nursing Homes
- Assisted Living Facilities
- Residential Care Facilities
- Independent Living Facilities
- Group Homes
- First Responders (Full-time, Part-time, Volunteer)
- Law Enforcement
- Fire Department
- EMS
- Department of Correction
- Individuals Age 80 and Older – Beginning 1/11/2020
