Anyone age 5 and older may now schedule a COVID-19 vaccination appointment.


Please note that anyone younger than 18 must receive the Pfizer vaccine. It is the only vaccine to receive Emergency Use Authorization from the FDA for that age group.

Booster doses are recommended for anyone 18 or older who received the second Pfizer or Moderna doses at least six months ago, or received single dose Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine two or more months ago.
