Meeting Called to Order at 5:00 p.m. with Pledge to the Flag. Present: Phyl Olinger, Ron Dittman, Steve Fishburn, Lorie Hurst, Chayse Thomspon, Randy Gundrum, and Auditor Christina Sriver. Not present: Pete Karas.

SHERIFF – Sheriff Heishman reported there are 71 inmates as of today. He is looking for other counties who need to have inmates housed for additional income. He has been looking into training deficiencies and found that less lethal training was not being implemented adequately; a senior correction officer is now being trained for this. There are now two federal inmates being held.

HIGHWAY – John Geier updated on department activities including cutting brush, mowing on the third pass and chip sealing. Chip sealing should be complete prior to Labor Day. Pug will then be laid.

FEDCO – Michael Ladd stated there was a meeting held concerning Blacketor Drive to discuss annexation; ten lots are being considered for annexation into the City due to restrictions currently in place. A housing symposium will be held at the Geneva Center upcoming. Michael has been working with the State on a program to bring veterans back to the county. The regional group will be hosting in two weeks, in Fulton County, to see what is going on in the county. There is an educational seminar concerning downtown redevelopment. This is in conjunction with RDP.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DONATION FUND FOR THE FULTON COUNTY JAIL CHEMICAL ADDICTION PROGRAM (JCAP)

WHEREAS, the County of Fulton has elected to establish a donation fund for the Jail Chemical Addition Program (JCAP) pursuant to I.C. 36-1-3 to receive donations for the purpose of running the JCAP program including but not limited to equipment, supplies, material, and promoting; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-1-3-6 requires a unit to adopt an ordinance prescribing a specific manner for exercising the power of home rule; and

WHEREAS, State Board of Accounts guidelines recommend using the 4100 series for establishing donation funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that there is hereby a fund created and named the JCAP Donation Fund and numbered 4102 and is established with the following purposes:

- 1. Receiving donations for the intent of supporting the Jail Chemical Addiction Program
- 2. Funds held in Fund 4102: JCAP Donation Fund will be used explicitly for the purpose of supporting the JCAP program.

Ron motioned to have a second reading by title only, seconded by Steve; carries 6-0. The ordinance was read by title only. The third and final reading will be held in the next regular meeting.
