Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Rochester, Fulton County, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the corporate boundaries of the City of Rochester be and they are hereby extended to include the following described contiguous and adjacent real estate, to-wit:

Lots Number 57 through 66 in Manitau Heights Addition, Section "C", and Lots 45 through 56 in Manitau Heights Addition, Section "C", revised, together with the streets and alleys adjacent thereto,

and said real estate is hereby annexed to the City of Rochester.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Rochester, Indiana, shall publish this ordinance once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Rochester, Indiana, and the first publication to be made on the 15th day of November, 1969.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY LOCATED IN FULTON COUNTY, INDIANA, AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ROCHESTER, INDIANA, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY

WHEREAS, the owners of the following described real estate:

Beginning at a point 2362 feet West and 20 feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 33, Michigan Road Lands, Said point lying on the South line of 18th Street, 20 feet South of the present corporation line of Rochester, Indiana; thence South 1 degree and 20 minutes West 283.74 feet to R.R. Iron post; thence North 43 degrees 10 minutes West 525.90 feet to a point on South side of 18th Street; thence East 369 feet to a P. K. spike; said point being point of beginning containing 1.63 Acres +.
