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The Board of Commissioners having been duly advised that the City of Rochester, Indiana did by its Ordinance No. 489 duly adopted on the 25th day of November, 1969, annexed certain territory located in the County of Fulton, in the State of Indiana, to the City of Rochester and have furnished the said Board of Commissioners a certified copy of such Ordinance; that by such annexation the certain territory which previoully was located in the County of Fulton and was a part of election precinct #6 of the County of Fulton will now become a part *Little Journal of Rochester*, Indiana to be coextensive with the present corporate lines of the City of Rochester, Indiana, as adopted in said Ordinance No. 489 and that the change of said boundary lines in said Ordinance No. 489 and the remaining boundary lines of Commission #6 and the Rochester City Precinct #3 to remain as is except for the change of the boundary lines required by said annexation under Ordinance #489, which change is as follows, to-wit:

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Rochester, Fulton County, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the corporate boundaries of the City of Rochester be and they are hereby extended to include the following described contiguous and adjacent real estate, to-wit:

> Lots Number 57 through 66 in Manitau Heights Addition, Section "C", and Lots 45 through 56 in Manitau Heights Addition, Section "C", revised, together with the streets and alleys adjacent thereto,

and said real estate is hereby annexed to the City of Rochester. SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Rochester, Indiana, shall publish this ordinance once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Rochester, Indiana, and the first publication to be made on the 14th day of Norember, 1969.

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ORDINANCE NO. 489 , 1969

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY LOCATED IN FULTON COUNTY, INDIANA, AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ROCHESTER, INDIANA, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY

WHEREAS, the owners of the following described real estate:

Beginning at a point 2362 feet West and 20 feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 33, Michigan Road Lands, Said point lying on the South line of 18th Street, 20 feet South of the present corporation line of Rochester, Indiana; thence South 1 degree and 20 minutes West 283.74 feet to R.R. Iron post; thence North 43 degrees 10 minutes West 525.90 feet to a point on South side of 18th Street; thence East 369 feet to a P. K. spike; said point being point of beginning containing 1.63 Acres +. This 1.63 acres has been divided into 4 lots with numbers from 11 to 14, exclusive of connecting street, platted as Lots 11, 12, 13, and 14 in Southwood's 1st Addition to the City of Rochester, Indiana,


