

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN INSURANCE PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN
RETIRED ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE COUNTY OF FULTON, STATE
OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, certain acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana authorize the establishment and maintenance of a group insurance program for retired public employees. And,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, Indiana, to establish such group insurance program for certain retired elected officials.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, Indiana, as follows:

1. That an insurance program be established for certain retired elected officials of the County, which retired elected officials shall include those officials holding office at the time of enactment of this ordinance and who are participants in the County group insurance program;

2. That the insurance benefits to be provided shall be identical with the benefits provided to all current employees of the County of Fulton;

3. That the retired officials covered by the group insurance plan shall be responsible for 100% of the cost of such plan to the County, and shall make payment of such amount to the County not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date the County premium is due. Any interruption in insurance caused by either the group insurance carrier or the employee shall disqualify them from remaining in the County plan.
