

ORDINANCE NO. 042087

WHEREAS, I.C. 11-12-6 provides for the establishment and continued funding of a county correction fund; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 11-12-6-6 provides that a county legislative body may annually adopt an ordinance to elect to receive deposits from the State Department of Corrections and to establish a county correction fund; and

WHEREAS, the county correction fund may be used only for funding the operation of the county jail, jail programs, or other local correctional facilities; and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body may elect to receive deposits at either Level 1, Level 2, or Level 3 funding; and

WHEREAS, Level 3 is the most appropriate level of participation for Fulton County; therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FULTON COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby elect to receive deposits from the Department of Corrections in accordance with I.C. 11-12-6.

SECTION 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby elect to receive such deposits at Level 3 funding.

SECTION 3. The "county correction fund", created for 1987 funding under this program is hereby continued, and is to be administered by the County Council of Fulton County. The fund shall consist of deposits received from the Department of Corrections in accordance with I.C. 11-12-6.

SECTION 4. The county correction fund shall be used for all purposes permitted by state law. Any money remaining in the county correction fund at the end of the year shall not revert to any other fund but shall remain in the county correction fund, in accordance with the statutes governing such fund.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect




