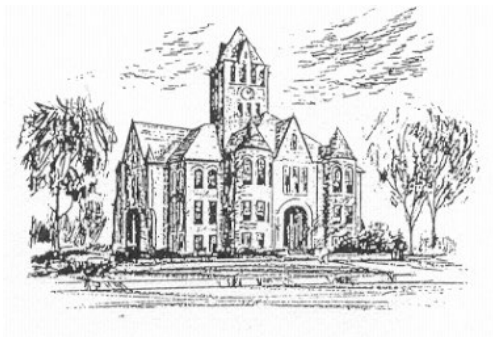

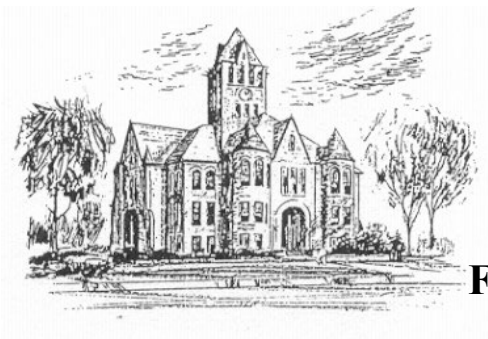
CVS- 1910 Main St, Rochester, contactless COVID-19 testing for patients age 3 and up.

Appointments Now available for the Fulton County Fairground Covid -19 Vaccine site

The CDC has issued booster eligibility guidance. Based on those recommendations, the Indiana Department of Health supports the administration of booster doses to individuals who attest to meeting CDC guidelines as outlined below:

- For individuals who received a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot at 6 months or more after their initial series:
 - 65 years and older
 - Age 18 and older who live in long-term care settings
 - Age 18 and older who have underlying medical conditions
 - Age 18 and older who work or live in high-risk settings

STARTING Thursday, November 4th 2021 Covid-19 vaccines will be available at the Fulton County Fairgrounds at the Everett Smith Building, 1009 W 3rd St, Rochester. IN 46975

More dates will come available if needed.

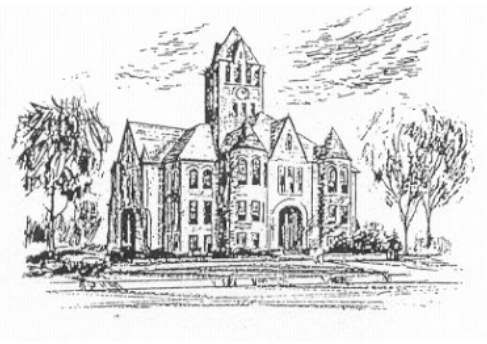
