

Before the Fulton County Board of Commissioners

Ordinance Number 10-07-96

An ordinance establishing stop signs for Mount Zion intersections, one North of Mount Zion bridge, and one South of Bridge. Roads effected by this ordinance are 500 East, 250 South, Mount Zion-Millark Road, and Wabash Road.

Whereas, the Fulton County Highway Department and Fulton County Sheriff's Department have completed a traffic study of the two Mount Zion Intersections.

It is therefore ordained that, the stop signs set forth in subsection one, supersedes all prior stop signs at these two locations.

It is further ordained that, Fulton County Highway Department will install the stop signs in accordance with subsection one.

(Subsection One)

Intersection just North of Mount Zion Bridge all ways stop.

- 500 East South Bound (Stop)
- 500 East North Bound (Stop)
- 250 South (Stop)
- Millark-Mount Zion (Stop)

Intersection just South of Mount Zion Bridge, 2-way Stop.

- Wabash Road (Stop)
- 500 East North Bound (Stop)

500 East, South Bound at South intersection only (no Signs needed).

This ordinance is effective upon passage.
